In this historic Coronation year, we're inviting readers to create and send in a photograph of a Coronation design entitled 'Coronation Chicken Wire' for a chance to be featured in the nation's favourite

floral art magazine. In line with King Charles III's views on sustainability, the design should use eco-friendly chicken wire (wire mesh) mechanics.

All you have to do is email ONE clear photographic image of your design with NO digital enhancement to editor@nafas.org.uk by 12pm on Friday 3 March 2023 with 'Coronation Chicken Wire' clearly marked in the email subject header.



How to take part

- The title for your design is 'Coronation Chicken Wire'.
- The approximate space for your design should be width 60cm, depth 60cm, height 90cm.
- Your design should be staged on a light-coloured, plain-topped surface with a matching or similarly light-coloured, plain background.
- The mechanics for your design should be wire mesh.
- All designs received will be assessed by the Editor and NAFAS Judges according to NAFAS rules in the *NAFAS Competitions Manual* (3rd Edition 2015) and a selection made to be featured in the magazine. The *Competitions Manual* may be purchased from the NAFAS website (nafas.org.uk).
- The Editor and Judges' decision is final.
- One submission per person. Designs should be original and not have been submitted elsewhere or on social media.
- By submitting your photograph, you are agreeing to future use of it by *The Flower Arranger* and NAFAS in any form including social media.
